Will be held alongside the Smokey Ridge Knife and Hawk throw.

Medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each event – Medals awarded after each event

REGISTRATION FEE-NO CHARGE

In appreciation for your participation, loyalty and thank you to the Smokey Ridge Muzzleloaders, we will not charge a registration fee to throw hawk and knife, as this will be the last year the Iowa Black Powder Federation holds this event.

RULES

Primitive Dress Encouraged.

Hawk blocks must be of wood that a hawk or knife will stick with a light throw.

All hawks must be either French or American with a wood handle 16 to 18 inches long. The tomahawk must be single edged and the edge must be no greater than 4 inches in length and not less than 2 inches.

No taped handles.

Each person may step off his/her distance at the start of the competition and mark it with a stick or stone.

The minimum of one full revolution of the hawk or knife is required.

The knife handle must be thicker than the blade and made of or covered with a natural material.

Participants in men/women must have attained their 14th birthday at time of match.

All youth (13 and under) must have an adult with them when throwing.

Hawk – 3 throws per block or total of 9 throws. Knife – 3 throws per block or total of 9 throws.

Cut-2

Piece off-3

Center stick for knife only-4
