Address of Beals Farm is 10842 North 103rd Avenue West. Collins, IA
Go 3 miles past intersection of Hwy 330/223 (Mile marker 3 on Hwy 330)
Drive slowly and bear to right. Pass in front of the two houses and go through
gate down into the pasture.

RULES

This is to be a traditional type shooting match held at 60 yards. Rifles are to be traditional type American firearms, either flint or percussion ignition and no weight limit. Open iron sights and patched round ball only. No adjustable open sights allowed – unless they have been taped over and essentially “non-adjustable” throughout the shoot. Shades permitted. No inlines. No swivel breeches or other double barreled guns. No coil spring operated locks. For under hammers, the trigger guards must be the main spring. No tri-pod stands or suede shooting bags.

Please note: If this is your very first over the log shoot, you will be allowed to compete with any style rifle, and with a coil mainspring, excluding inlines. You may use a log as a rest or bring your own “chunk”. Also needed, a pencil, a staple gun or quilter’s pins for posting targets and a tarp or something for you to lie on. Chunks will be furnished or you may bring your own. Sand bags, padding may be used.

You are to post your own target and then pull the target and give to range officer to be scored. This is 10 one shot targets, no time limit. Everyone will post targets at the same time and relay will last until everyone has fired. There will be a first place winner in each relay. All targets are scored from the center of the X to the center of the shot hole. Shortest measure is winner. (Any shot fired outside target ring is scored as 2 inches.) All 10 targets are combined to make aggregate and there will be a first, second, third place medal for over all winner.

NMLRA Rules and regulations will be followed.
